This plan will outline the region's major transportation investments over the next 20+ years.

We want to hear your ideas about how to make it safer and easier to walk, roll, bike, take transit, or drive where you want to go.

Project Schedule

We will be asking for public comment on the draft plan from October 8-November 12, 2024. The plan will be completed in December.

GOAL 1: SAFETY

Provide for the safety and security of people walking, bicycling, rolling, riding transit, and using automobiles.

Provide equitable access to destinations, such as employment, essential services, and recreation, through a variety of travel options.



GOAL 4: PRESERVATION

Maintain the region's transportation infrastructure in good condition.



GOAL 5: ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Support a thriving and growing region through strategic transportation investments.



GOAL 6: QUALITY OF LIFE/ HEALTH/ENVIRONMENT

Invest in a transportation system that promotes a high quality of life for all residents, including public health and environmental sustainability.








Fatal/Serious Crashes




WHAT WE HEARD FROM YOU

Over 4,300 surveys received and 25+ community events attended











There are 867 miles of bike lanes, paved paths, and shared roadways (bike routes) throughout the region.

399 of those miles are considered "high comfort facilities" which are appropriate for all ages and abilities.

Resulting in an emissions reduction of over 5 million pounds of CO2.



Hybrid and electric vehicles account for about 5% of total vehicle registrations in our region.

Hybrid registrations have more than doubled since 2017.


