RTC is responsible for a transportation planning process that reflects the needs of our community.



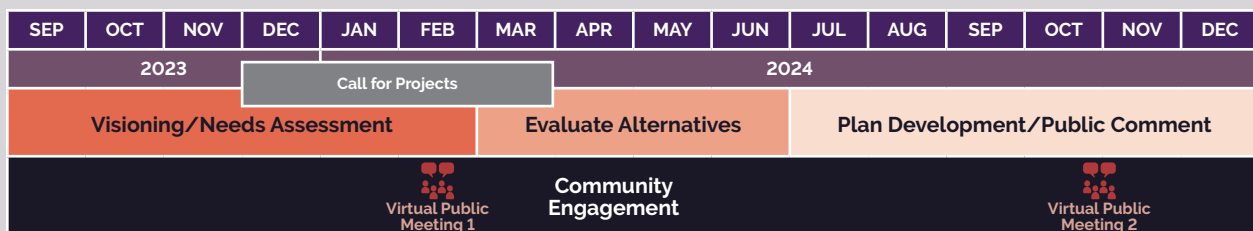
## Why is the plan important?

## Our Vision:

### GOAL 1: SAFETY

Provide for the safety and security of people walking, bicycling, rolling, riding transit, and using automobiles.



### GOAL 2: MOBILITY

Ensure efficient and resilient movement of people and goods.



### GOAL 3: EQUITABLE ACCESS

Provide equitable access to destinations, such as employment, essential services, and recreation, through a variety of travel options.



### GOAL 4: PRESERVATION

Maintain the region’s transportation infrastructure in good condition.



### GOAL 5: ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Support a thriving and growing region through strategic transportation investments.



### GOAL 6: QUALITY OF LIFE / HEALTH / ENVIRONMENT

Invest in a transportation system that promotes a high quality of life for all residents, including public health and environmental sustainability.

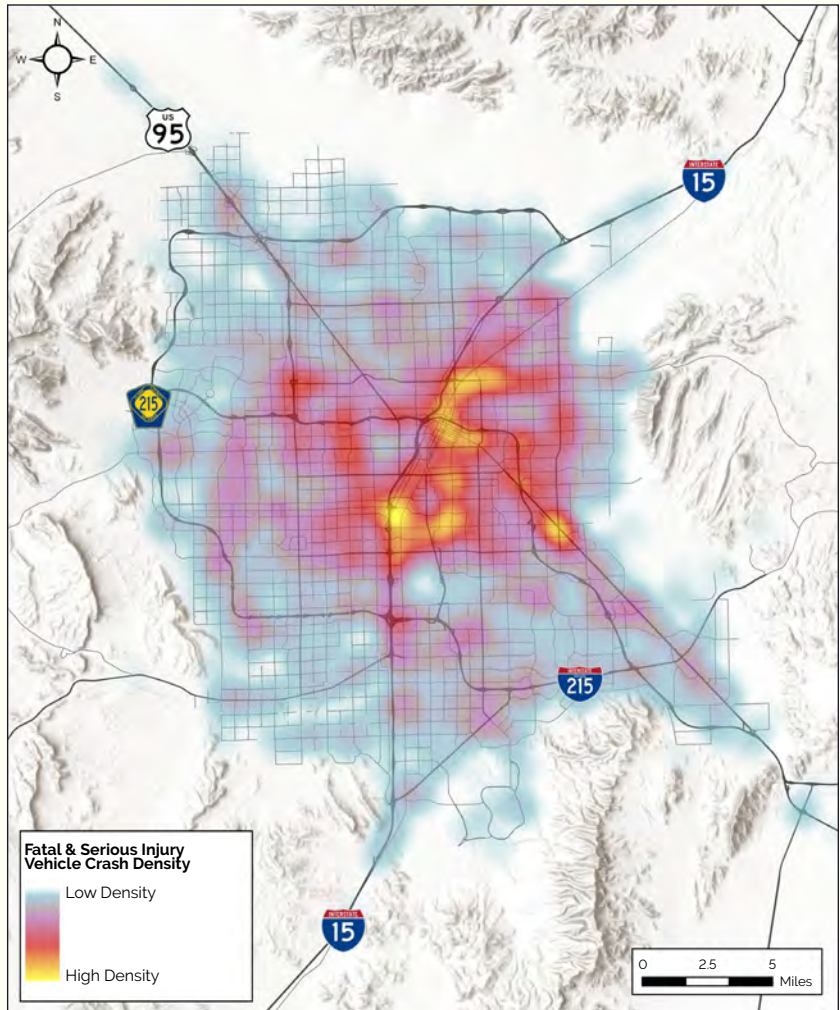




# SAFETY

Many of the region's fatal and serious injury crashes occur on higher speed arterial roadways, especially at intersections.

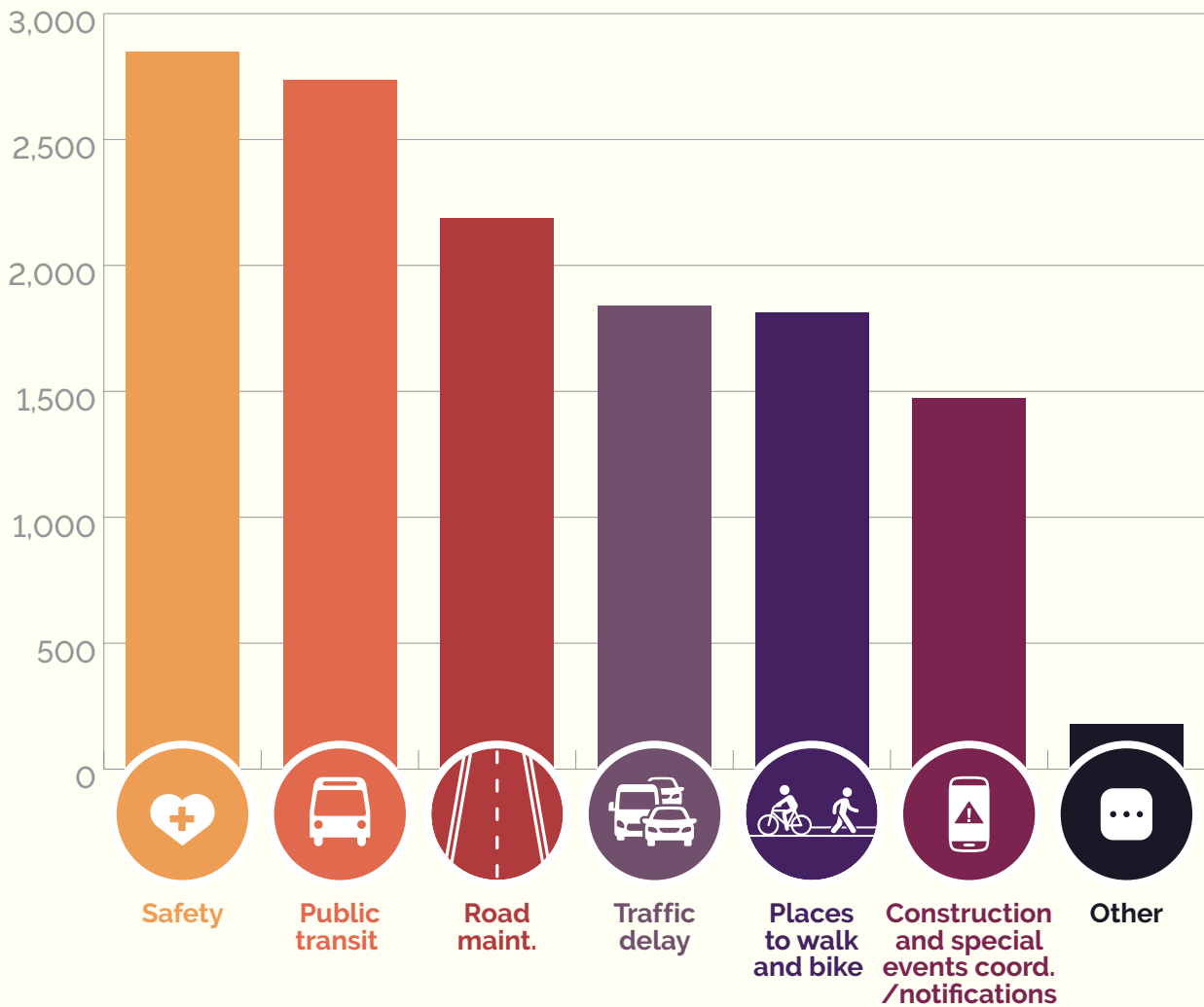


# WHAT WE HEARD FROM YOU

# MULTIMODAL



There are **867 miles of bike lanes, paved paths, and shared roadways (bike routes)** throughout the region.

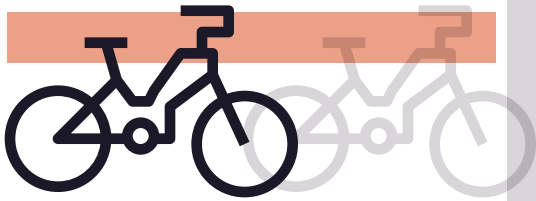
**399** of those miles are considered "high comfort facilities" which are appropriate for all ages and abilities.

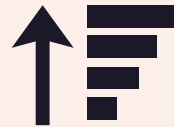
Hybrid and electric vehicles account for about **5%** of total vehicle registrations in our region.

Resulting in an emissions reduction of over **5 million** pounds of CO<sub>2</sub>.

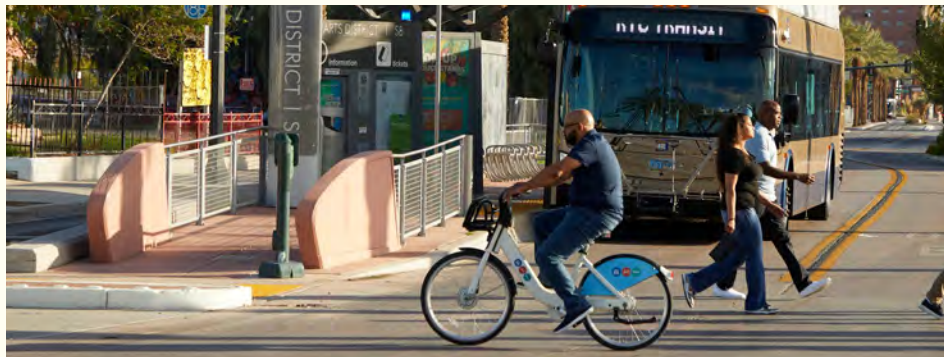
Hybrid registrations have **more than doubled** since 2017.

were taken on our transit system in 2023

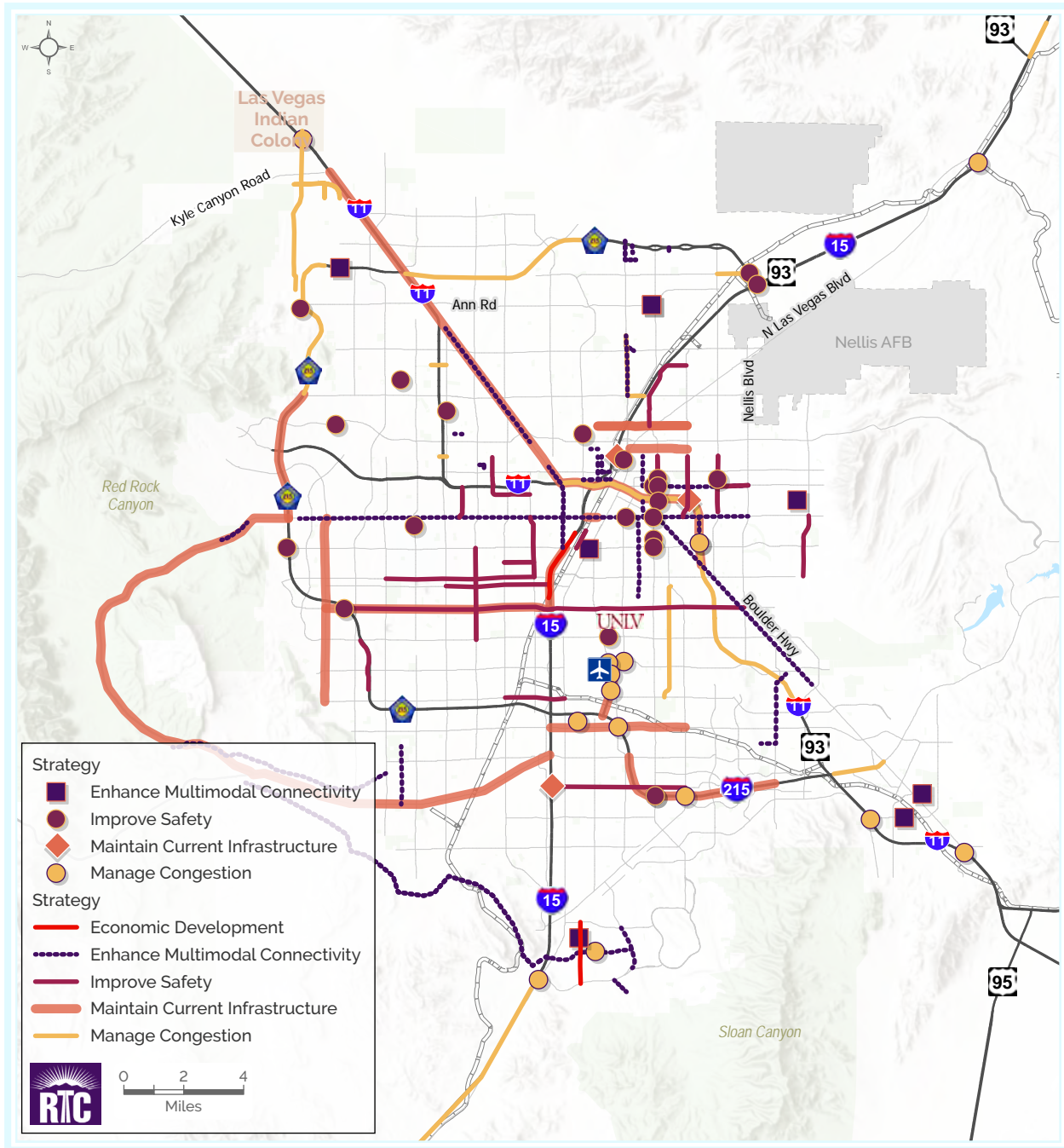
