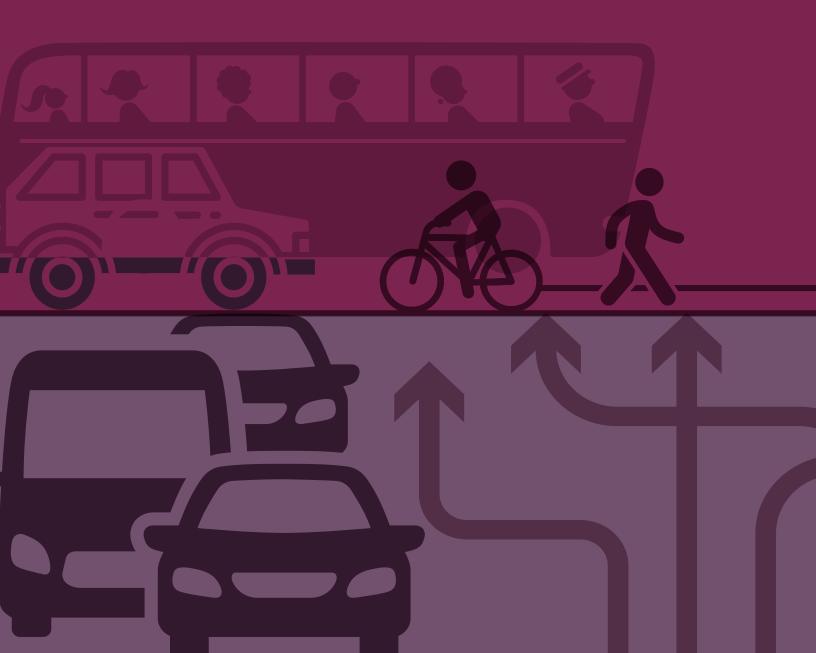

In February 2024, the tragic death of a 15-year-old student in the area underscored these safety issues, as she was struck by a vehicle while on her scooter. With two nearby charter schools surrounded by warehouses and heavy truck traffic, the lack of sidewalks further limits safe commuting options. One tragedy is too many. Implementing dedicated bus routes would improve student safety, support community mobility, and promote environmental sustainability. I do not want to see any more public dollars toward road or highway widening - our roads are wide enough, and it bears out in how unsafe it is to use our roads. Data doesn't capture how many "close calls" but there are far too many for comfort. I find that the projects have not been explained in enough detail to really give a sense of what the changes will be to expect by 2050. This makes it more difficult for the public to make any sort of comment about them. Individual projects really won't move the needle in terms of changing behavior, but the whole network of bike paths, PROTECTED bike lanes, and transit hubs needs to be considered holistically. This seems like a laundry list of backlogged projects rather than anything that will move our transportation network into the next half of the century. There already are so many road construction projects taking place, why aren't we changing the standard to just build it right the first time instead of waiting for federal and state grant programs to redo certain sections to be safer?
